CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

This is a unique year on the Liturgical Calendar. As you recall, Valentine's Day fell on Ash Wednesday. As odd as that was, Easter will fall on April 1, yes, April Fool's day. While there are many theories as to the origin of April Fools, everyone knows the tradition of playing practical jokes. Having successfully tricked someone, you can triumphantly announce your gag by shouting, "April Fools!"

Just as Valentine's Day has little in common with the day of fast and abstinence that begins the Season of Lent, so April Fools is an insult to the holiest day on the Church's calendar – Easter, commemorating the Resurrection of Jesus. However, with a second look one can discover a profound truth in this odd combination. In reality, the world often looks at Catholics, indeed, all Christians, as fools. There are many voices in our culture that are quite blunt and open in condemning and mocking us.

Rather than being insulted or hurt by that, we can embrace that rejection with love and honor. After all, Jesus was ridiculed and mocked, and so were His followers from the beginning. As the Day approaches when we celebrate the Resurrection while others observe a trivial tradition of gags and pranks, here is a passage from St. Paul to ponder:

"For as I see it, God has exhibited us apostles as the last of all, like people sentenced to death, since we have become a spectacle to the world, to angels and human beings alike. We are fools on Christ's account, but you are wise in Christ; we are weak, but you are strong; you are held in honor, but we in disrepute. To this very hour we go hungry and thirsty, we are poorly clad and roughly treated, we wander about homeless and we toil, working with our own hands. When ridiculed, we bless; when persecuted, we endure; when slandered, we respond gently. We have become like the world's rubbish, the scum of all, to this very moment." (1 Corinthians 4:9-13)

In short, it doesn't matter what the world thinks. We serve the Lord. We proudly assist those in need, spread charity, work hard, support our parish, and love God. I would rather be a fool for Christ than a hero to a culture that rejects Him. I am proud to be Catholic and rejoice in the Resurrection of Jesus! Happy Easter!

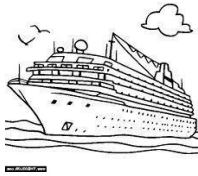

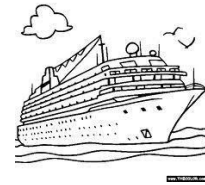

Over the centuries, generations of men throughout the world have known that one of their main responsibilities was to form their boys into competent men of good character, teaching them the virtues of wisdom, courage, self-control and justice. St. Paul teaches us that Jesus improved upon those virtues, with the addition of faith, hope and love. - **12:50** Prize raffle, and conclusion

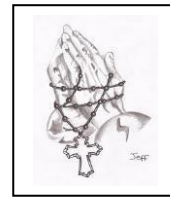

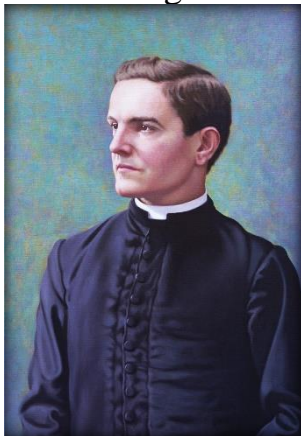
