CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

It is easy to forget that Easter is a season and not just a day. We see the same challenge at Christmas. People are aware of preparing for Christmas but then the day after feel as if it's over. During Lent Catholics often do something extra, make sacrifices, and attend special liturgies, and then after Easter have the same feeling that it's over. The Church continues to celebrate the Resurrection for fifty days until the great feast of Pentecost.

In that spirit, here is a suggestion of how to continue to celebrate Easter. I'm sure you already know the Stations of the Cross. Did you know that there are Stations of the Resurrection? They are also known as the "Via Lucis," or "The Way of the Light." There are fourteen stations and each one remembers something that happened from Easter until Pentecost. Here they are:

1. Jesus Rises from the Dead (Matthew 28:1-10)
2. The Finding of the Empty Tomb (John 20:1-10)
3. The Risen Lord Appears to Mary Magdalene (John 20:11-18)
4. Jesus Appears on the Road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-27)
5. Jesus is Known at the Breaking of Bread (Luke 24:28-35)
6. Jesus Appears to His Disciples in Jerusalem (Luke 24:36-43)
7. Jesus Gives the Disciples the Power to Forgive Sins (John 20:19-23)
8. Jesus Strengthens the Faith of Thomas (John 20:24-29)
9. Jesus Appears by the Sea of Tiberias (John 21:1-14)
10. Jesus Tells Peter to Feed His Sheep (Primacy of Peter) (John 21:15-17,19b)
11. Jesus Commissions the Disciples on the Mountain (Matthew 28:16-20)
12. Jesus Ascends into Heaven (Acts 1:6-12a)
13. Mary and the Disciples Wait in Prayer (Acts 1:12-14)
14. The Holy Spirit Descends at Pentecost (Acts 2:1-13)

I invite you to pray and meditate on these Stations throughout the Easter Season and continue celebrating the Resurrection. It's not over. It has only begun!

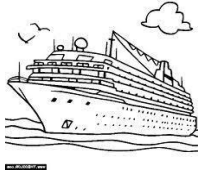

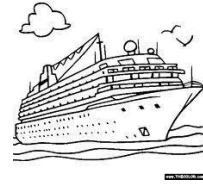

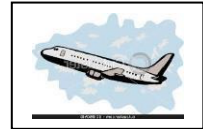

This year, just like the previous years, the Chapter will be staying in Wildwood at the Reges Hotel, located along the Atlantic Ocean on Atlantic Avenue. The dates for the 2018 State Convention are May 18 and 19th. Hopefully, we will return to the terrific weather we experienced in the past. Reservations will be processed on a FIRST COME, FIRST CHOICE of room basis. Act now and mail the enclosed reservation form a check and email for the full amount payable to "Ocean County Chapter" to the reservation chairman listed below. All reservations are due by April 20, 2018. The Chapter must make final payment for all rooms one month prior to the convention weekend.

Room prices range from \$110.00 to \$145.00 per night based on double occupancy; there was an increase in rates from last year. Children 15 & under stay free, each additional person will be \$20 per night. I have included in the rate the 14% tax we have to pay the Reges. We have four different styles of rooms to choose from. 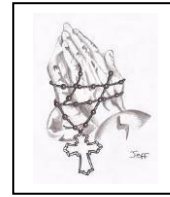

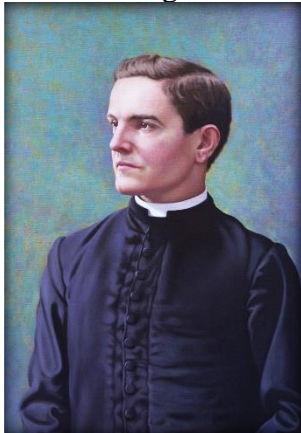
