We have 10 people attending the ORTL conference on April 7th. A big thanks to Francis Parker on getting the paper work filled out.

Round Table Report (Ricardo Hernandez & Jesse Villarreal):

Jesse Villarreal, Duane Kloser, Grand Knight Dave Bernklau and Ricardo Hernandez met with the Hispanic group on Wednesday, April 4th at 7:00 PM.

The Round Table meeting on April 4th was exceptional. All five new members that were just initiated last month were present for their first Round Table meeting.

Eleven members present including the Grand Knight David Bernklau. All Hispanic members are very anxious to get started with their own programs in conjunction with the parish. Their first attempt to work together will be a to put together a dinner for Mother's Day on May 13th. The Grand Knight will obtain necessary permission to use church facility for the occasion. Ricardo will talk with Father Arturo.

Detail of job description was given to all who volunteer to work. One responsible person was assigned to each of the jobs. Set-up and final cleaning was to be done by all present.

Food would be prepared by a local license establishment to comply with local and state health kitchen requirements.

Four annual events were planned. Dates to be selected with church secretary.

Discussions on recruitment events and planning to participate with Second and Third Degrees were shared.

Updates were done of phone and e-mail addresses for all the members.

Dues were brought up to date.

New Business:

The budget was amended slightly and approved by the council members. The contingency fund is a little over \$5,000. Ron will send it out to all members by Email and/or regular mail.

Ron Suchanek started the process to drop delinquent members from our council that cannot be located or are more than 3 years delinquent on dues. Ron needs to determine if the financial benefit of making Double Star Council is worth it long term to pay almost \$19 in dues to Supreme and State versus dropping them. The larger the council gets, the more difficult it will be to recruit enough members to obtain Star Council in the future.

John Fontana is working on rescheduling the trip to the Abbey sometime in May for the Building the Domestic Church program.

Brother Knight Eddie Herrera sent a Thank-you letter to the Knights for the card he received last month. Eddie will return home to Oregon in June.

Dave requested another alternate for the state Convention to be held on April 27-29th in Lebanon. Ricardo Hernandez and Dave Bernklau are Canby's delegates, with Tony Davis and Ron Suchanek as alternates.

John Meyerhofer gave a reminder to everyone to save May 18th - 20th for the Knights fishing trip over to Three Rivers. Those attending need to get their vehicle information to John ASAP.

Ron Suchanek requested names for anyone that still needs a badge, hoping to get them in this year's budget. There is no charge to members, but Lady Knight badges are \$10. Jesse will ask the Hispanic group on Wednesday.

Steve Heli volunteered to head up the nominations for the election of new officers for the 2018/2019 fiscal year. Please give him some recommendations and volunteer.

Grand Knight Dave Bernklau and Deacon Jerry Giger talked in detail about the Ushering Ministry. This is a very important ministry that covers a lot more than just ushering. There will be specialized training for security, 1st Aid CPR, wheel chair accessibility and just knowing what to do when an emergency occurs. This ministry needs to include the Hispanic men and women that are involved in their mass.

Jesse Villarreal reported on the Hispanic Round table and what has been happening in St. Pal Minnesota, where a new council has been formed for each of the last 7 years. They are using new techniques to recruit Hispanic's to get them to be leaders in their councils and actively participate in Knights of Columbus activities. Canby's council has more than doubled in size mainly due to the efforts of Eddie Herrera, Jesse Villarreal and Ricardo Hernandez and the commitment to integrate them into our council activities.

Insurance (Sonny Van):

Sonny reported that the IRA tax filing is due on April 4th. He congratulated our council on reaching 200% of their quota, with 16 new members this year. We need to continue to recruit a few new members this year to allow for drops for delinquent dues. Sonny did not know if the incentive for a tar council was different than a double star council. Rob Suchanek will research.
