CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

Did you know that almost seventy-five percent of the population suffers from some form of dehydration and thus are not operating at full capacity? Our bodies are made up of 75% water and it is important to drink enough water. Water helps with so many of our basic body functions so that if we are lacking we cannot be fully healthy. It is not uncommon for someone to be hospitalized because of dehydration. I still remember constantly reminding my dad to drink water (something I'm not so good at myself!). To be healthy we must have enough water in our body.

As basic and important as that advice is, it is amazing how many of us ignore it. We are now in the season of First Holy Communions. Almost every parish will be filled with adorable children and excited parents and grandparents as these little ones receive the Body and Blood of Jesus for the first time. Unfortunately, too many do not look past that one special day. They are focused on that ceremony but do not see down the road. Like water, God's life is essential to our spiritual health. Jesus told us, *"Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the Flesh of the Son of Man and drink His Blood, you do not have life within you."* (John 6:53)

Not receiving Communion regularly affects our spiritual health just like not drinking water affects our physical health. I invite you to pray for all of our children and their families as they celebrate this special day. Let us pray that they realize that it is more than just one day. It should be the beginning of a lifetime of a relationship with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. But, let us also look inside our own hearts. We have been privileged to receive Communion many times. It is so easy to take it for granted and forget how much we need the Eucharist.

After His teaching on the Eucharist, many left Jesus. At that moment, Jesus turned to the twelve and asked, *"Do you also want to leave?"* May the response of Peter also be ours: *"Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that You are the Holy One of God."* (see John 6:66-71)

INSURANCE MATTERS

Only Having Insurance "Through Work" Doesn't Work

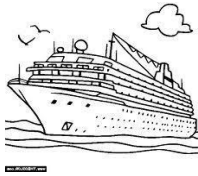

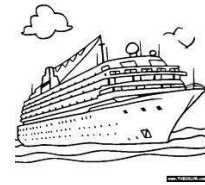

The dates for the 2018 State Convention are May 18 and 19th. Hopefully, we will return to the terrific weather we experienced in the past. 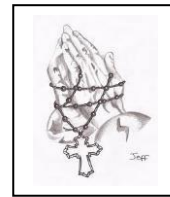

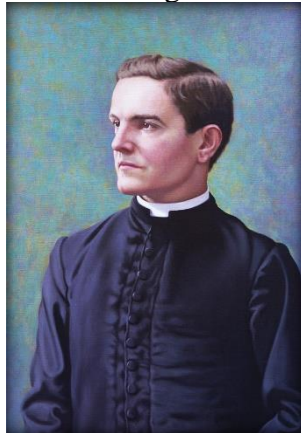
