CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

I have often shared at funerals that that I believe that none of us, myself included, have any idea how much God loves us. While it is at the foundation of our Faith, many do not fully grasp that profound and beautiful truth. I also believe that the greatest gift we receive when we die in the Lord is to finally know how much God loves us. Imagine. What will that be like to finally stand in the presence of God, the presence of Perfect Love?

Sadly, too many Catholics do not understand that this love of God is at the foundation of everything we do in the Church. For too many think instead that the Church is only an institution with a bunch of rules and regulations. While the Church is an institution and does have rules and regulations, that is not the essence of our Faith.

The second Friday of June is the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. While devotion to the Heart of Jesus goes back to that moment when blood and water poured forth from His heart on the Cross, the formal feast did not come until many years later. Devotion to the Sacred Heart was promoted by St. John Eudes and St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 1600's. Jesus told St. Margaret Mary in a vision of His concern about the indifference and coldness in the world in response to His love. Sadly, that can also be said today.

As Knights, as Catholic gentlemen, we are ambassadors of Christ's love. With charity as one of our pillars, each of us is commissioned to proclaim and live this profound love of God. We share this love with our brother Knights, of course, but also to those we serve, to those alongside us in the Church, and, indeed to all we meet.

I invite you to have a special devotion to the Sacred Heart and use this feast to rededicate yourself to our principle of charity. Through our words and actions, may more and more people come to know the great love God has for them!

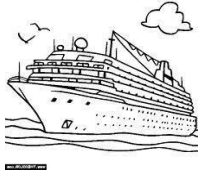

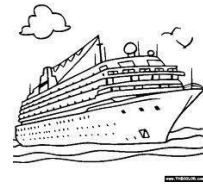

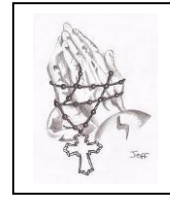
COLUMBIAN CLUB #3826 MESSAGE

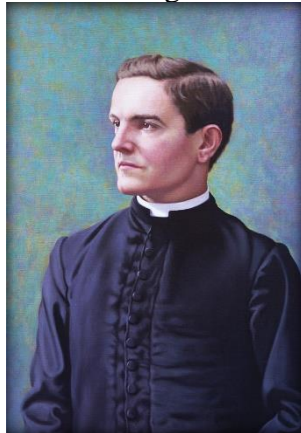
