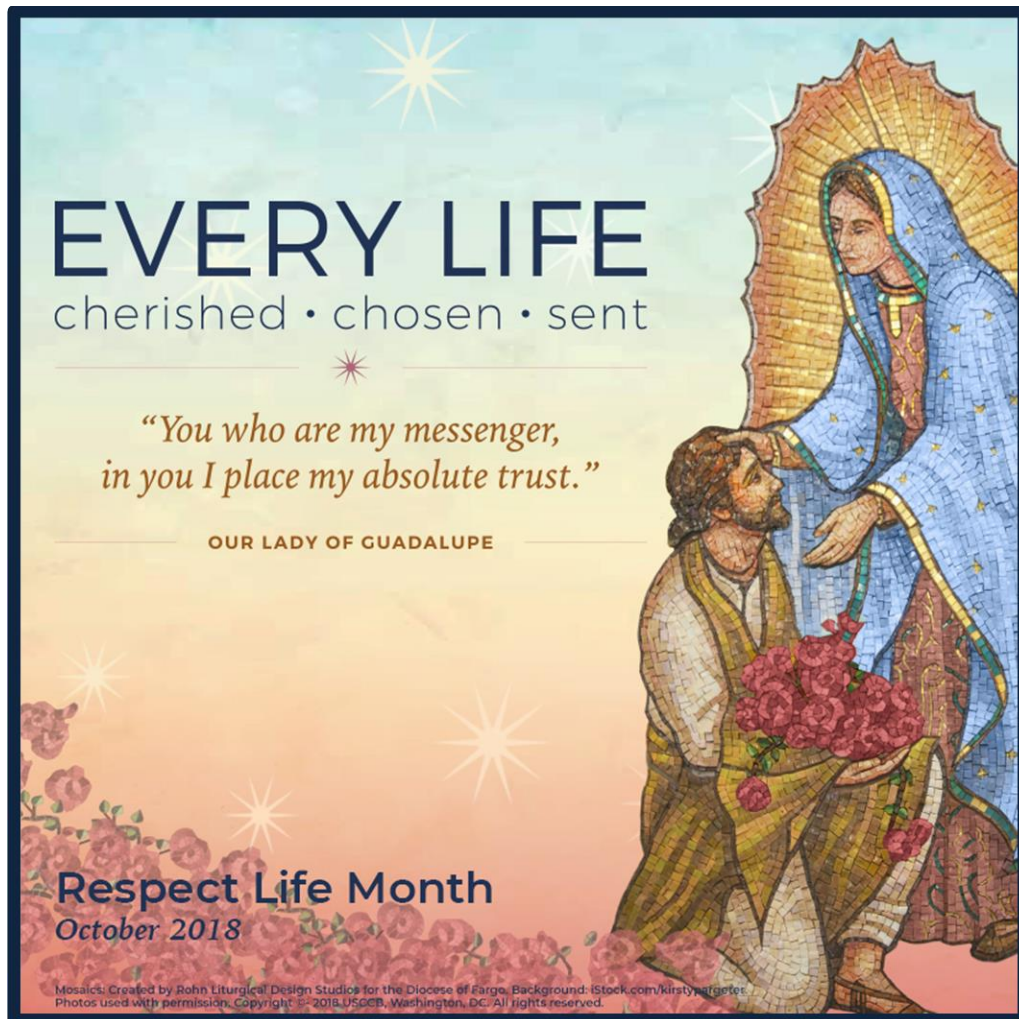

VETERANS DAY 2018

Veterans Day, once known as Armistice Day, will be celebrated on Sunday November 11, 2018. It will be the 100th anniversary of the end of World War One. On that day the bells of Saint Mary's will be rung, as bells rung 100 years ago, on the 11th Month, 11th Day and the 11th Hour, as the guns of World War One fell silent.

At the 11:30AM Sunday Mass, that day at Saint Mary of the Pines, all Veterans will be honored and especially the 116,708 American Military personnel who lost their lives in that conflict.

Through the efforts, of our counsel and our assembly, one fallen soldier PFC Joseph Lorino from New Jersey, after 100 years, will receive posthumously at this mass, the Purple Heart, World War Victory Medal, N.J. World War Victor Medal, Italian World War One Interallied Victory Medal. All to be presented to his family.
