Worthy VSM, To close the loop with you and everyone, on Saturday, 10/5/2019, the 4th Degree chalice inscribed with SK Mack J. Miller's name upon his death in 1966 by Assembly 25 in Ft. Smith, Arkansas, that came into the possession of FN John Seifert (Assembly 2958) in Dublin TX, a couple of weeks ago, was presented to his 90-year old granddaughter, Ms. Callie Shelton, at her home in Paris, Texas, by FN John Seifert and PFN Mike Waguespack of Assembly 2958 (Granbury, TX), accompanied by FN Rick Gramlich of Assembly 25 (Ft. Smith, Arkansas), and SK Don Babb and Lady Cathy Babb, Assembly 3324 (Sulphur Springs, TX).

We then visited SK Mack's grave site in Paris, TX with the chalice. Afterwards, we presented the chalice to Fr. Denzil Vithanage, Pastor of Our Lady of Victory Catholic Church in Paris, TX, where the chalice will rest at the request of Ms. Shelton.

It was an emotional day for all of us as we returned the chalice to its rightful place. Ms. Shelton was extremely grateful.

Fort Smith Assembly 25 Fourth Degree Chalice Finds Its Home

Recently, a Fourth Degree chalice inscribed "SK Mack J Miller-Ft Smith Assembly-Fourth Degree Knights of Columbus-1874-1966" came into the possession of the Faithful Navigator of One Nation Under God Assembly 2958 (Granbury, Texas). The chalice was found in a box at the home of a now-deceased former parishioner at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Dublin, Texas. Initial attempts to identify SK Mack J. Miller and his connection to Dublin, Texas, proved negative. As a result, Assembly 2958 reached out to Right Reverend Monsignor Patrick F. Horan Assembly 25 in Ft. Smith, Arkansas, where it was thought the chalice originated, in an effort to identify a living relative of SK Miller so that the chalice could be returned to its proper home. Concurrently, Assembly 2958 began an extensive on-line search for information relating to Mack J. Miller that included reviewing records available in Ancestry.com.

Following several days of research, Assembly 2958 determined that SK Mack James Miller is buried in Paris, Texas. Additional research determined that SK Miller's wife, his son, and his daughter are also buried in Paris, Texas. As a result, Assembly 2958 contacted the Grand Knight of Our Lady of Victory Council 7696 in Paris, Texas, who is also a Sir Knight in Father Joe Dean Assembly 3324 (Sulphur Springs, TX), to determine if anyone had knowledge of the Miller family. After providing Council 7696 with a copy of SK Miller's daughter's obituary, Council 7696 was able to quickly identify a living granddaughter of SK Miller who is now 90 years old and currently a parishioner of Our Lady of Victory in Paris, Texas. It was also determined that SK Miller's daughter had been an active parishioner of Our Lady of Victory and was a member of the Altar Society there prior to her death in 1985.


During contact with SK Miller's granddaughter by Council 7696, SK Miller's granddaughter expressed her wish that the chalice should be returned to its proper home at Our Lady of Victory in Paris, Texas, where SK Miller, his wife, and children are buried and where several of his descendants were/are active parishioners. The mystery still remains, however, as to how the chalice found its way from Assembly 25 in Ft. Smith, Arkansas, in 1966 to a former parishioner at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Dublin, Texas, in 2019. Nevertheless, the chalice is now in its proper home.

Council 7696 Grand Knight was also able to locate the grave site of SK Miller at a cemetery in Paris, TX. The grave site was unkept and the marker was overgrown with grass. Council 7696 Grand Knight and his son have since cleared the overgrown grass and are repairing the marker at the grave site, as well as at the site of SK Miller's son.

SK Miller's Fourth Degree Legacy Lives On Four Generations Later

During its research, Assembly 2958 was able to identify and contact the great granddaughter of SK Miller's sister who has a family tree in Ancestry.com that contains a link to SK Miller. Following the identification of SK Miller's granddaughter in Paris, Texas, Assembly 2958 followed-up with the great granddaughter of SK Miller's sister. Her response was as follows: "I imagine this will mean a lot to them. My son is a Fourth Degree Knight at the University of Notre Dame. (jr year) His involvement with the organization is really important and special to him."




















FC Art Sellers informed us we move up to 138 members, Sir Keith Mason is reinstated, Glad to have you back.
