Grand Knights Report

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Dave also mentioned that the budget year for 2019/20 will start July 1 to match up with our Parish and the State/Supreme budget year.

Director Reports (Ricardo Hernandez):

Ricardo Hernandez talked about the technique used for Hispanic recruitment where they can attend the Round Table meetings to learn more about the Knights before ever see a form 100. Father Arturo is more supportive of those inquiring about the Knights at the Hispanic mass and gives a blessing to those that want to learn more.

Ricardo is continuing to work with the Hispanic Knights on what equipment is needed to perform church landscaping, saving the Parish close to \$13K per year. Five groups of five have been requested, with a reserve group to fill in as needed. Ricardo will provide details later on what activities will actually be included in the maintenance schedule. Material expenses could reduce the savings, at least for the 1st year. An offer has been made to the entire Parish to get involved in this Ministry.

Ricardo will work on getting the TV's mounted in the Parish Center and Vestibule of the Church in near future. There is more to this than just mounting the TV's; it will include forever playing of past and future events at St. Pat's for the smaller TV's in the Parish Center and the church.

Ricardo mentioned that he will be Membership Director at the State level, replacing Mike Woody. He is having a meeting in the next week with Mike to learn the ropes on what the position entails when he takes over in July. Congratulations for all his hard work over the last year to earn the respect to do this job, especially since the number one goal for 2019/2020 is Hispanic recruitment.

The Widow / Widowers dinner has been scheduled for June 30th from 4-6 PM. Paul Crawford normally coordinates this event, but now is one of the guests. We need a volunteer to step up for this fun and gratifying event to show our appreciation and to remember them.

The Consecration of Families to the Holy Family (Blessing), one of our Faith events was done by Fr. Arturo on Mother's Day. Thanks, Dave, for coordinating this with Father.

Dave congratulated Jesse for his award as co-Knight of the Year for the great effort in Hispanic Recruitment and the establishment of Round Tables in Oregon. He was on the road many weekends, traveling for KC 4th degree exemplifications as State Master and 1st, 2nd, 3rd degrees put on by other councils around the state. A well-deserved award Jesse.

Everyone needs to thank Ron and Ricardo for coordinating the Mother's Day breakfast, held on Sunday, May 12th. The attendance was down from last year for both the Anglo and Hispanic breakfast. Normally, we have approximately \$150 in additional expenses over income for this event, which was true this year.

Mike Robert talked some more about the Soup Supper for Foodbank for the new Helping Hands program under Community. He is looking at doing it again this summer, but providing the food close to those waiting in line to pick up their food. Other options may include giving them a container to take the food home versus eating it there. They are very set on the process and it's hard to get them to deviate from it.





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Questions about funding the last retreat brought up the need, in the future, to vote on re-allocated funds for amounts payed out over \$500. Also, we need to request funds and vote earlier so we don't have a last-minute rush. A mistake was made on the process to re-allocate funds to the Pascua Easter Youth Retreat and Ron Suchanek apologized for the mistake.

New Business:

There were several changes made to the proposed budget for next year before it was approved. Ray Brown was elected to come back with guidelines on what can be spent from the Tom Swain fund without council approval. Also needed are recommendations to replenish this fund when it becomes depleted (Budgeting / Fund Raisers).

Lots of discussion on the process to select the organizations to give money for Charity. Some wanted the organizations to be named before the budget was approved, but Duane convinced the Knights to leave it as a lump sum, knowing that a team has been selected for the last 3 years to come back with the details before August 1st for approval by the council. This provides more flexibility in picking new charities versus always keeping the same old list year after year.
