He was employed at Union Wire Rope Corp., served in the United States Army working on scientific projects, became a Project Engineer Armco Steel Corp., until his retirement. He subsequently worked for Schroer Mfg. Co. and the KC Star as an engineer. Ray was an Eagle Scout, Semi-Pro basketball player, and an avid golfer. He married Dorothy Wymore on October 1, 1955. They had a daughter, Karen Kline, who is an animal behaviorist, and son Dr. Randall Kline. Ray had many interests. He was devoted to his Catholic Christian faith and served it at every opportunity. 
