Update on Protecting God's Children/Vulnerable Adults Compliance. Father Martin is seeking 100% compliance with the Archdiocese directives for all events at St Clare of Assisi. This includes Felice Cuores. The parish is required to have on file a current background check on every employee and volunteer interacting with children or vulnerable adults.

Brenda Pfeffer, Child Safety Coordinator at St Clare is tasked with ensuring compliance. I have been in frequent contact with Brenda who will assist us. Phase one is to get full compliance for every member of our operating committee. Please cooperate with Brenda when she contacts you. She has assured me of minimal intrusion of your time. Be kind; remember she is the messenger.

# PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN AND VULNERABLE ADULT'S PROGRAM COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS





St. Clare of Assisi Church and School follow the Archdiocese of St. Louis Safe Environment Program (Protecting God's Children). The program is designed to help protect the youth, elderly, and vulnerable adults of our parish as they participate in activities within our community. This process also provides a layer of protection against the possibility of false accusations for those adults who are involved in our many ministries.

All volunteers, coaches and employees are required to be 100% in compliance with the Archdiocese of St. Louis Safe Environment Program (Protecting God's Children) prior to beginning their work within the parish.

### Requirements for our PGC program are:

- 1. Attend a Protecting God's Children Workshop
  - a. To register for a PGC workshop, please go to: virtus.org
  - b. Click on "FIRST-TIME REGISTRANT" on the left side menu. Then click on "Begin the registration process".
- 2. Complete a Worker's Registration Form and return it to Brenda Pfeffer. This form is used to run your background check. All fees will be paid by St. Clare.
- 3. Read and sign the Code of Ethical Conduct. This can also be done on-line at the time you are registering for a PGC workshop.
- 4. If you are a coach, you are required to take the on-line coaching class, which can be found at this link: <a href="http://www.cycstl.net/coaches/coaches-training-program">http://www.cycstl.net/coaches/coaches-training-program</a>.
  Once you have completed the on-line coaching class, you will be given a Coach's ID number which will be listed on your certificate of completion.

Please visit the Safe Environment tab on the St. Clare website for additional information. All questions, required forms, and coach's ID numbers should be submitted to Brenda Pfeffer, Child Safety Coordinator, <a href="mailto:bpfeffer@saintclareofassisi.org">bpfeffer@saintclareofassisi.org</a>.



Recently cash prize money has been increased.


