#### History Lovers? - STUMPHOUSE TUNNEL


An incomplete railroad tunnel for the Blue Ridge Railroad. First proposed in 1835 by residents of Charleston as a new & shorter route between Charleston and the Ohio Valley. In late 1850s construction was successful <u>until hitting the mountains in Oconee County</u>. Stumphouse Tunnel was begun and didn't get very far; construction was stopped after 1,617 feet in 1859 as over a million dollars had been spent. In the early 1950s the tunnel was used by Clemson to grow blue cheese until an air conditioned room was built on campus. It is now a public park and registered on the National Register of Historic Places.


### Off-Road Lovers? - JUMPING-OFF-ROCK

Jumping-Off-Rock, an iconic viewpoint above Lake Jocassee within the Jocassee Gorges in northern Pickens County, can now be accessed all year round. The Jumping-Off-Rock area is one of the prime destinations on Jocassee. It has beautiful views and supports one of South Carolina's two pairs of nesting peregrine falcons. When the falcons assumed residency six years ago a new overlook was created near Jumping-Off-Rock to avoid disturbance of the nesting falcons. The overlook is one of the most remarkable vistas in the Upstate. The beautiful view of Lake Jocassee and the Blue Ridge Mountains is truly a must see!

#### White Water Rafting Lovers? - WILDWATER CHATTOOGA

Nestled in the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains within Oconee County, the Chattooga River, made infamous in the 1971 movie classic "Deliverance", flows south along the state border of South Carolina and Georgia. Bull Sluice is the prominent rapid on the river. Section 3 rapids and one big rapid at the end, is an easy stretch suitable for ages 8+. Section 4 is the pinnacle of Southeastern white water with its famous Five Falls of tight, technical Class 4 and 4+ rapids in a beautiful gorge; suitable for ages 12+. Ziplining is also a highlight through the Chattooga Ridge Canopy Tours where you fly through the trees overlooking the Chattooga River Valley.



### Energy Lovers? - WORLD OF ENERGY

Whether you are looking to fill an hour or spend an entire afternoon, the World of Energy keeps you entertained and informed. Begin with a tour of the educational exhibits inside the education center. In addition, there's as much to see outside. With three nuclear reactors, Oconee Nuclear Station is one of the nation's largest nuclear plants. Since beginning operation in 1973, it has safely and reliably generated more than 500 million megawatt-hours of electricity. Don't forget to pack a lunch as the picnic shelter overlooks the beautiful shores of Lake Keowee and is the perfect way to end a visit to the World of Energy!



### Train Lovers? - HUB CITY TRAIN MUSEUM

Take a step back into history and learn about how the railroads were connected to the textile & peach industries in SC. Check out the display about the Hayne Car Shops that once employed 1,100 to maintain the Southern Railway's fleet of railroad cars. The trackside observation deck is available to view the Norfolk Southern trains that pass by the depot. Also featured are the individual railroads of Southern, Clinchfield, C&WC, P&N and Glenn Springs.


