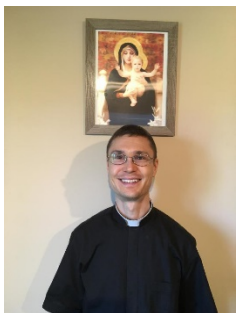
January Family of the Month

Our Fredericksburg Council 4034 charter was issued on May 24, 1955. Sixty-four years later we have over 400 members and conduct over 25 activities, resulting in Events on our calendar, some once a year, others monthly and some spanning several days. From Thanksgiving to New Years, we have need for volunteers practically every day. All our volunteering directly supports our Faith, Family, Community and/or Life activities. In addition, in order to maintain our very high commitment to these activities we need to attract new Knights.

Four the last 4 to 6 years, we have left our website, www.KofC4034.org, dormant and only infrequently published a newsletter, The Knight Crier. Members communicated by phone and email, and a few attended the various monthly council meetings. We now have revised our website including making it useful on mobile devices and, thanks to Anthony De Maio, are publishing the Crier monthly. If you are reading this, you either downloaded from the Mail Chimp email notification of a new Crier or downloaded it from the website.

The main objectives of www.KofC4034.org is to keep our members informed as well as support Recruiting and support Directors and Chairman attracting members to sign-up to volunteer or participate in our Events. The public pages are focused on "JOIN US IN MAKING A DIFFERENCE." They describe What We Do, Steps to Becoming a Knight, the Insurance program and all the various ways to Contact Us. The Members pages include links to The Knight Crier, our Calendar (July 2019 to June 2021), State and Supreme sites. The main focus of the Members page is "CLICK HERE - TO VOLUNTEER." It currently provides a path to information and a sign-up sheet for each of a dozen different recurring activities scheduled on the Council Calendar. There is no need to wait for recurring calls for help. If you have worked an Event for a few years, no need to wait to sign-up for later in the year. Nothing attracts volunteers more than to see they are not the first to sign-up! The list will soon be expanded to include over two dozen different activities. Many of these result in multiple events on the calendar, some recurring monthly while others daily for a specific short period of a couple/few days.

Future plans for development of www.KofC4034.org include providing a secure

LOGON to Members Only and creating the ability to use PayPal to pay dues.

Items for Proposed Council Resolutions:

Other than the Ultrasound, HCA Lunch Debt and Cornhole Tournament pass-thru budgeting items, the items below have been discussed around the council many times for completion. The Corona Virus hit the stock market hard however, our America Funds continue to do well. The council must make several decisions whether to repair/improve our property or move. Request as brothers and members of both the council and FCC we consider and prioritize the items below for discussion and approval 12 Feb 2020. See you there.

1. Consider proposal to increase council approved \$12,000.00 for the purchase of an ultrasound for Choices Women's Center, the cost is actually \$13,500.00. The council needs to discuss, approve and amend the \$1,500.00 it is the difference to match

Supreme's 50 percent to place the Ultrasound machine at Choices. Additionally, the Ultrasound Maintenance Agreement cost is \$6,144.00 which will be offset by our District 11 Councils and a council from Caroline County. Total for Ultrasound Machine and 2 yr. maintenance agreement is \$19,676.00. The council must also discuss funding the ultrasound through the America Funds and use the maintenance agreement donations from the other councils to fund the maintenance warranty.

2. Consider proposal received to pay off HCA Students Luncheon Debt for this school year. Currently debt is \$1,500.00 with the potential year end debt being between \$3-4K

3. Consider proposal to add a \$2K line item to FY Budget for the VKCCI Cornhole Tournament expenses as a pass-thru. Expenses will come out of registrations.

4. Consider proposal to replace FCC ceiling estimated at: \$7,000.00.

5. Consider proposal to replace flooring in kitchen, bathrooms and hallway estimated \$6,000.00.

6. Consider proposal to spackle and paint FCC. Council buys paint, members paint, \$?00.00

7. Consider proposal to have an Interior Decorator, potentially a brother/family member or someone familiar with the KofC to organize/design wall space use for awards, pictures and other items in the hall to obtain the most pleasant atmosphere possible. \$?000.00

The projected estimate for items 2 thru 8 is approximately \$22,500.00 with the \$19,676.00 the ultrasound cost a total outlay of funds is approximately: \$43,176.00.

Consider that our council does not have the millions it would take to purchase land, nor the money to build a new council home purchase if land were available. Most likely we

could not purchase another building locally in Fredericksburg without having to assume a mortgage, which would be expensive and the council would need to raise money to make payments each month. Lastly, the council cannot depend on a bishop's/pastor's good will if dedicated space was made available at St. Mary's there's no telling when or why that space could/would be reallocated to another purpose. It would appear our council's best served to repair our council home for future years of service to its members. However, this is a council decision. The council home requires repairs/upgrades, we should be moving forward prioritizing them with the FCC to effect their completion. As these projects are approved anyone with expertise in our council is welcome to assist obtaining estimates, rehabbing project areas etc. These are council and FCC issues and we are all council and FCC members.
