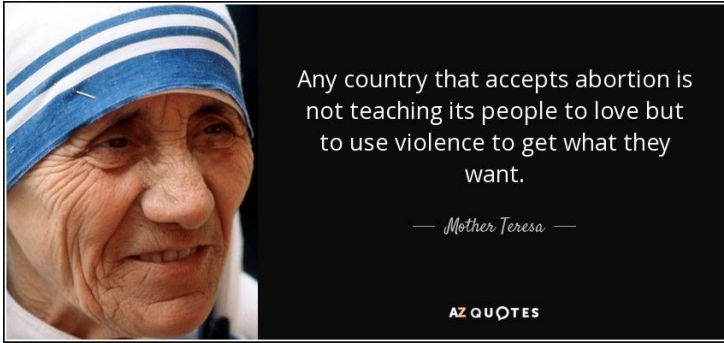
Our next dance will be held on Saturday March 14th. The theme for March is St Patrick's Day and will be hosted by the Holy Infant Auxiliary.
