Deacon's Beacon

Dear Brother Knights,

Following is some "food" for reflection from 2005 but continuing to be active and alive:

In chapters 6 & 8 of Mark's Gospel we read of Jesus' multiplying a few fishes and loaves to feed many, and in this we are reminded that He doesn't necessarily need much from us in order to provide changes, even miracles. Just as in those examples of His requiring little, my attention was drawn to just a few words from a writing by Saint Augustine (Office of Readings on the Feast Day of Saint Nicholas, Bishop, December 6) and reads in part as follows:

".....Peter had denied Christ three times, and to counter this he must profess his faith three times. Otherwise his tongue would seem quicker to serve fear than love (my emphasis),"

In just these ten short words, "his tongue would seem quicker to serve fear than love," we can be brought to reflect on, not only fear, but many other things our tongues might seem quicker to serve than love. Perhaps an examination of conscience exercise using the words, "My tongue would seem quicker to serve _____ than love," substituting the following words for the word "fear" might be helpful during this time of Advent, this time of preparation: gossip, ridicule, unjust criticism, deceit, deception, crudeness, uncleanness, ego, indifference, resentment, anger, un-forgiveness, justification, and the list goes on ...

My Scripture concordance lists at least thirty-four Scripture passages containing the word "tongue," with most of them cautioning us of its use. May the Holy Spirit help us recognize all that prevents us from reflecting Christ. God bless you.

MEN'S CURSILLO WEEKEND

THE CURSILLO WEEKEND?

During the three days of the Cursillo weekend from Thursday evening to Sunday evening, people from all walks of life grow close to one another. Religious and lay people form a living, working Christian community to gain a deep awareness of the treasures and responsibility of their faith. The goal of the Cursillo weekend is to give those who make it a new understanding of Jesus Christ, the basic Christian truths, and the desire to serve the church.

The Cursillo weekend is a blend of seriousness, light heartedness, spiritual exercises, talks and discussions. The teachings of Christ are discussed within an atmosphere of joy and song. There are meditations and talks by priests and laymen, and everyone making the Cursillo weekend is urged to participate by taking notes, discussing, and even by making drawings that illustrate major points.

The Cursillo weekend ends at the close of the three days. However, the whole point of the Cursillo movement is that ordinary people can steadily grow in the love and service of God and man for the rest of their lives. Christian growth is not easy, but the Cursillo weekend provides a framework for it, both during the three days and afterwards. In the Post-Cursillo, emphasis is on maintaining a vibrant and growing Christian community, thus springs the apostolic action required to make ours a better world to live in.

For many, a Cursillo weekend is a new awakening to a deeper friendship with Christ.
