You will find that we operate out of two Catholic schools, Our Lady of Lourdes in the Diocese of Orlando and St. Joseph School in the Diocese of Venice along with Methodist, Jewish and Baptist schools. We have been invited to open a school in Jersey City by the Superintendent of Schools. The Archdiocese of Newark has approved us to open at Our Lady of Victories School in Jersey City. As you can see what I did to help my son has turned in something bigger than I imagined.
