Chaplin's Report

Brother Knights,

As many of you are no doubt already aware, the month of October is designated as Respect Life month throughout the Church in the United States. The purpose of having such a month is to increase awareness about the many issues that face us in modern society as we attempt to defend the sanctity of human life. It is also meant to reinvigorate and recommit us in our prayer for the most vulnerable in our society. As you are also aware, the Knights of Columbus are instrumental in many of the Pro-Life activities of the Church, including being the primary organizers of much of what goes on surrounding the March for Life in Washington D.C. in January. The call to defend the sanctity of life is one that is the duty of all Christians by virtue of their baptisms. It is rooted in story of creation, which we first learn in the Book of Genesis. God created each of us individually, and he has given us the gift of life. In turn, he has also called us to be stewards of that creation. We live that out by our following of the greatest commandment of Jesus: loving God with our whole heart, mind and soul and loving our neighbor as ourselves. Our neighbors include, not just the unborn, but also the elderly, the immigrant, the abused, those who are sentenced to death, the sick, and the dying. A consistent ethic of the sanctity of human life is what is required of us, because the teaching that is foundational to this ethic requires us to protect life in all its phases and in all circumstances. It is my hope and prayer that the Knights continue to be at the forefront of these important issues in our Church, and examples for society as a whole.

I would also, before closing like the thank you, brother Knights for all the work you accomplished for our awesome International Fall Festival and for the parish picnic. As always, St. Barnabas is grateful for your presence and help on these events. On a personal note, thank you for honoring me during the recent First Degree exemplification. Receiving the certificate was very humbling for me personally.


