No Prayers Allowed at Vets Burials

Allegations of religious censorship at a Houston cemetery prompted VFW's Commander-in-Chief to issue a statement in July expressing the organization's outrage that veterans constitutional rights are possibly being violated.

"Generations of patriotic Americans have fought, bled and died to help defend the U.S. Constitution, which guarantees fundamental rights of religious expression and freedom of speech," VFW Commander-in-Chief Richard L. Eubank said. "Those basic tenets are clearly being violated at the cemetery."

According to the Texasbased Liberty Institute, VA and the director of VA's Houston National Cemetery, Arleen Ocasio, have engaged in "religious viewpoint discrimination" in violation of the First Amendment and the *Religious Freedom Restoration Act*.

"They've told VFW and the American Legion that they cannot have prayer during the burial services of our veterans, unless the family requests it in writing and submits the prayer for pre-approval," said Jeff Mateer, Liberty Institute's general counsel.

Liberty Institute has filed suit against VA and Ocasio on behalf of VFW, the American Legion and The National Memorial Ladies. VA says it "values and respects" veterans and their families rights to a burial service "that honors their faith tradition." Ocasio has issued no comment, despite repeated requests.

"This is a classic case of a bureaucrat running amok," Eubank said. "In spite of VA policy, the cemetery director is making up her own rules and has imposed hurtful, unilateral restrictions of her own choosing."
