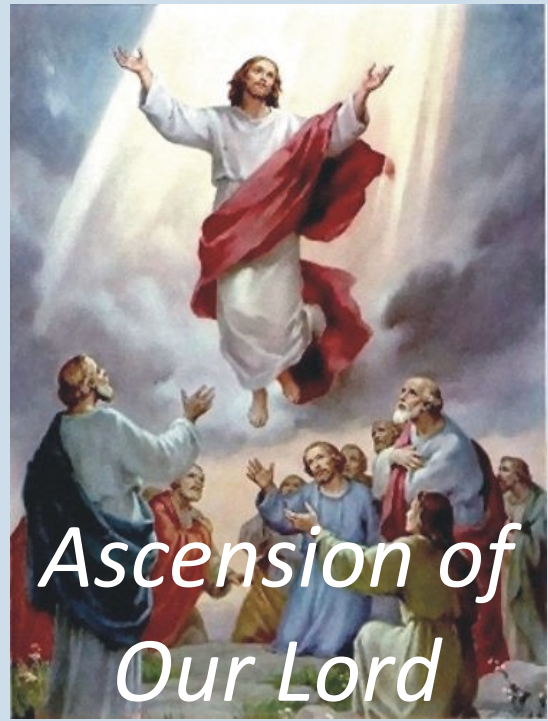
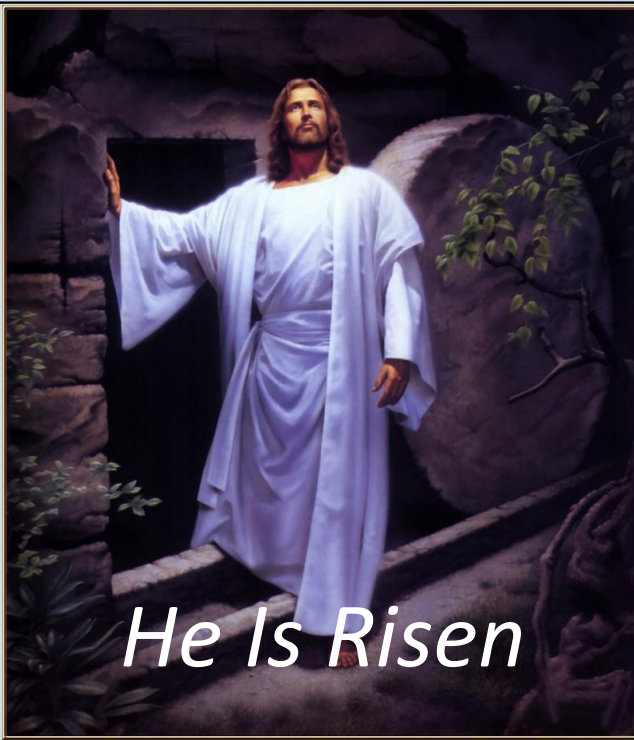

God Bless you and your families.

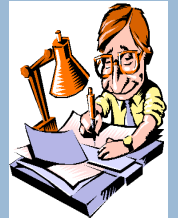
