Church Activities & Pro-Life Report

My Brother Knights,

As we close on this Lenten season, I want to update you on some of our projects this lent and let you know about our upcoming Bible Study.

Wednesday Simple Suppers and Pray Services:

We had great attendance and support at our weekly Simple Suppers and the various prayer services that followed. The Wednesday evening sponsored by our KofC Council was very well done. Our Deputy Grand Knight, Tommy Webb, and his wife, Joann, prepared an outstanding meal and Brother Wendell Vice and his team did an excellent job of leading the parish in the Stations of the Cross. We also provided "Guides to Confession" pamphlets to parishioners at our Parish Communal Penance Service.

\$40 for Lent:

When we first approached Father and Pat with this idea for a self-denial program to assist our Food Pantry replenish non-food items, we never thought it would be as successful as it has. Just a little over half way through Lent and the program has already brought in over \$3,000 in cash and gift cards and loads of sacks of non-perishables. Do you sense the Holy Spirit at work? Final numbers to come!

St. Joseph Table:

We received many thanks from the St. Joseph committee for our assistance in helping to set up and in particular the tear down and clean-up. Thank you to those of you that helped.

4th Sunday Breakfasts:

Our 4th Sunday breakfasts that are co-sponsored with the Men's Ministry continue to be well attended. These breakfasts provide a sense of community as well as a small source of revenue for both of our groups.

Corporate Communion:

We had our fist Corporate Communion, Knights and their families attending Mass together as a group, to commemorate the 130th anniversary of our Order's founding. We had an outstanding turnout and the Officers are considering making these a regularly scheduled event - possibly the 5th Sunday of any month - more to come!

Parish-wide Bible Study:

Sponsored by our Council and the Men's Ministry, we will be facilitating a five week Bible Study program for the Parish beginning Thursday, April 19th.
