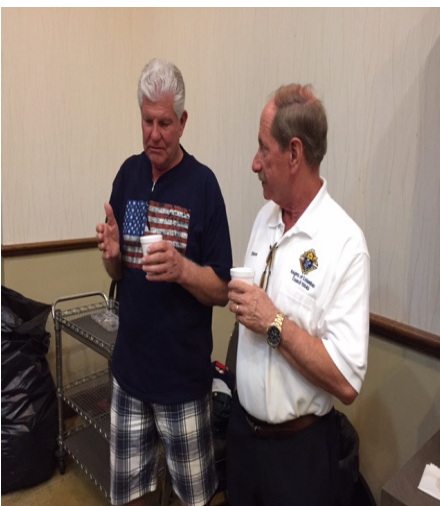
Our next Council Meeting is this Thursday April 27th at 7pm. See you then!

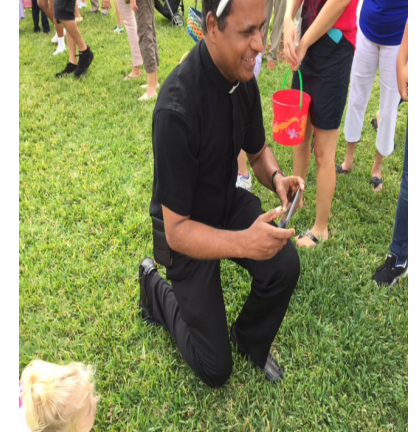
