The commitment of personnel to work on Thursday, May 2, 2019

\square The commitment of personnel at 5:30 a.m. at the PCC on Saturday, May 4, to make breakfast tacos for the parade route ??? drivers and gators
\square Signup sheets will be available at the next two Wednesday meetings and at the TACO Breakfast on April 7 th
\square Sign up personnel Saturday morning, May,4th (10:30) at the CORNYVAL site so we are ready to go when the CORNYVAL gates open at noon following the conclusion of the parade
\square Personnel to sign up for Friday and Saturday nights (busiest times)
