I have been truly saddened by the news that Walt Heim and Rich Lipko have passed away. These men were exemplary in their dedication to the Knights of Columbus. More than that, they were just great guys

Walt Heim and I had worked together on the Columbus Days Social, our Memorial Breakfast and the Pasta Dinner. Walt had a natural way of keeping things in perspective when I would order for these events. He had all the numbers and he knew what we needed.

He kept me calm with his demeanor, and knowledge.

Walt seemed most at home in our Council Home Kitchen. When I would watch him making dinner for the Chapter Christmas party, or the Columbus Day Social, he was in the best spirits. He was even present in our hoagie sales where the meat would be delivered from his shop.

But his love was Sister's Night. He was so happy on those occasions. Working with Dan Olivieri, Dan McNamara, Paul Dugan, and a Manhattan, they made a great meal. It was almost as if the

camaraderie they shared was cooked into the meal. And I have to say watching Walt carve was like watching an artist paint or a sculptor model something.

I always wanted to cook with him. He looked like he was having so much fun, and since I know my way

around a kitchen, I knew I would learn something, and have a good time.

Walt also had words of advice and praise. He was always telling me to take the time to spend with my kids. He would remind me that family comes first, and he was right. I never walked out of a Mass where my kids served that he did not compliment them. I am willing to bet that this was not just special to me; rather, anyone of you could tell similar stories or pay better tribute.

Rich Lipko and I took our First Degree together. In the years that followed, he worked behind the scenes fixing things, and trying


