On April first this year, we celebrate Easter Sunday. Without the beautiful event of Jesus rising from the dead there would be no Catholic Church or Knights of Columbus and many would never have met. It's always interesting on Easter Sunday to see so many so called Catholics, just like Christmas. Got news for them and others who think like them. The fiery preacher Billy Sunday once said, "going to Church and obeying laws doesn't make you a Christian any more than going to the garage makes you an automobile." In other words, if we are not living our faith and sharing it by our words and example, we are wasting our time.

I am always glad to see April go and taxes with it. May, however, is a month I look forward to. Besides nature coming back to life, it is the Month dedicated to Mary.
