

Established during an economically difficult time for communities, Food for Families ensures that families have adequate access to nutritious food.

Although the economy may have improved in some areas, many families still need food assistance. In fact, some councils have seen families who previously donated to food pantries more recently come to the same pantries to receive donations.

Since its launch in 2009, Food for Families has expanded significantly. In 2015, Knights collected more than 11.4 million pounds of food and \$7.2 million in donations for soup kitchens and other food programs.
