Our Special Role To Seminarians

We often take for granted that the Knights seriously support vocations, especially our priests. It is a fundamental part of who we are and what we do. But have you ever stopped to ask yourself why, that amongst all the good Catholic organizations out there, the Knights have a unique calling to support the priesthood?

We can break down our support of priests into three phases: encouragement of those entering the path towards priesthood, support of those living their vocation, and comforting of those priests in retirement. To better understand the special role the Knights play, let's look a little closer at the young men contemplating and entering the seminary.

What these young men are considering doing with their lives is really quite radical – they are considering passing up married life; passing up children; passing up pursuit of material wealth; passing up potentially successful careers in business – in order to enter a vocation to serve us. And not only that – but a vocation that is routinely attacked and abused by modern society.

When I was 22 years old, I only had two things on my mind – making money and chasing girls. I suspect many of you would agree that most 22 year old men are often the same way. And guess what? The young men entering the seminary are not immune to these same desires, but instead are choosing this sacred vocation. I am humbled

to think about the good choices these guys are making compared to my own less than stellar choices made many moons ago.

But it is men like us Knights who can look back on our own youth and at least have some comprehension of what these young men are going through – we at least have some inkling of the struggles they must be facing as they make this choice and pursue this holy vocation.

Thus, we can play a special role in helping support them as they proceed on their journey towards becoming priests of our church. We send gifts each month to our seminarians – we give them special gifts on their birthdays and Christmas – we support the Fort Worth Diocese in support of all seminarians - and these are all good. But we need to stay connected as well – let them know we and our family are praying for them – visit them when we can – let them know you have some understanding of the struggles they are facing.

These guys often think about what their peers who did not choose their path are doing. And at times, it is normal for them to feel uncertainties over their choice. But we Knights are uniquely qualified to be present in a special way at these times. To let these guys know they are loved and treasured by the entire church. And to stand in support of them as they work towards being priests of the Church.
