

Kevin Mulligan Answers His Call to The Priesthood

On Wednesday August 18th at Michaels Grill and Bar at the Westover Country Club twenty fellow Knights joined Kevin Mulligan, our Brother Knight, to celebrate his entering the seminary before the end of this month.

At the end of 2007 Mulligan transitioned from a career as a sports writer covering among other things the Philadelphia Eagles from 1990 to '96 and major golf tournaments such as the Master's for the Philadelphia Daily News and other newspapers to working for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia's Office for Communications. He was now on the other side of journalism helping the media tell the good news of the Catholic Church in the Archdiocese.

Kevin Mulligan is about to enter the seminary and begin studies toward ordination as a priest." Mulligan said. "The more I prayed about it in perpetual adoration (of the Blessed Sacrament) I came to really believe that God wanted me to be a priest. Kevin will begin studies for the Philadelphia Archdiocese this September at Blessed John XXIII National Seminary in Weston, Mass. It is geared toward men age 35-60 studying for the priesthood from dioceses throughout the United States.

Kevin said he has no fear of the future and looks forward, God willing, to five years of seminary formation and its completion with priestly ordination. "With God holding my hand, I'm going to be very happy as a priest." At the heart of Mulligan's journey is spending time with the Lord in prayer, especially adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the rosary. "There is no substitute for a Holy Hour with the Lord". If more people would experience that they'd find how valuable a personal encounter with the Lord is. This is where it all happened for me."
