If you have not looked at your June issue of the *Columbia* I suggest that you do. On page 12 the Supreme Coun- Faith in Action works and more details cil introduced a new service model called "Faith in Action." It consists of 4 categories labeled: Faith, Family, Community, and Life. Under each category are 8 programs that a Council or District can work on. Upon meeting the criteria for a program the Council or the combined District of Councils are awarded credit. Any Council that earns credit for completing 8 pro-


