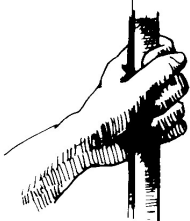

MEN'S CURSILLO WEEKEND

THE CURSILLO WEEKEND?

During the three days of the Cursillo weekend from Thursday evening to Sunday evening, people from all walks of life grow close to one another. Religious and lay people form a living, working Christian community to gain a deep awareness of the treasures and responsibility of their faith. The goal of the Cursillo weekend is to give those who make it a new understanding of Jesus Christ, the basic Christian truths, and the desire to serve the church.

The Cursillo weekend is a blend of seriousness, light heartedness, spiritual exercises, talks and discussions. The teachings of Christ are discussed within an atmosphere of joy and song. There are meditations and talks by priests and laymen, and everyone making the Cursillo weekend is urged to participate by taking notes, discussing, and even by making drawings that illustrate major points.

The Cursillo weekend ends at the close of the three days. However, the whole point of the Cursillo movement is that ordinary people can steadily grow in the love and service of God and man for the rest of their lives. Christian growth is not easy, but the Cursillo weekend provides a framework for it, both during the three days and afterwards. In the Post-Cursillo, emphasis is on maintaining a vibrant and growing Christian community, thus springs the apostolic action required to make ours a better world to live in.

For many, a Cursillo weekend is a new awakening to a deeper friendship with Christ.

Brother Knights,

When I asked Fr. Lavan what the Knights can do to assist the parish, and he said “cleaning and disinfecting after Masses”. In order to qualify, you must (1) be between the ages of 14-64, (2) in good health (no pre-existing medical conditions), **AND** (3) be **SAFE** environment compliant. If you satisfy #1 and #2, but **NOT** #3, call me or email me and I can help you. Make this a family project, it only takes about 5-10 minutes after Mass. We have about 14 Knights (and some families) helping already but could use more. Volunteerism is what the Knights are all about, and if you are **NOT** “safe compliant”, please make every effort to comply. Note that **ALL** volunteers must be safe-compliant to attend any event on Holy Angels church property including our council meetings, pancake breakfasts (when we can do them again), etc.

This month we lost Brother Ron Nolan due to an accident where he fell at work, had complications, required emergency brain surgery, but in the end the damage was too great. This is a good reminder that **ALL LIFE** is a gift from God, and we don't know when we'll be called home. I do know we need to be prepared, and we do that through prayer and fasting. We are blessed with so many opportunities to unburden ourselves of sin by going to Holy Confession. Some people think “God knows my sins and I don't need to go tell a priest”. Well, the Catechism of the Catholic Church says we **DO** need to go to a priest, at least once per year. But why wait that long. Our Lady wants us to confess monthly, and receive the grace that her Son bestows upon us. The priest **IS** Jesus in the confessional. Don't be afraid if it's been a while, the priest will help you, and who doesn't need “extra grace”. It makes us better Fathers, Brothers, Spouses, Sons.

May God abundantly bless you and your families.

Building the Domestic Church

“No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son wishes to reveal him.” (Gospel for July 5, Mt 11:27)

Have you ever known a man who was just like his father; who not only looked like him, but also acted, spoke and thought like him? Jesus is the very image of his Father and reveals the Father to us. By striving to know God the Son more intimately — through prayer, the Mass, the sacraments and Scripture — we also come to know God the Father more intimately. May we better understand the Father’s love for us and model our own fatherhood after his.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori: This month, I challenge you to commit to at least one hour each week in prayer before Jesus in the tabernacle, spending some of this time meditating on God the Father. Second, I challenge you to work with your brother Knights to implement the Faith in Action Holy Hour program in order to help others grow closer to Christ.

Questions for Reflection: What is the difference between “knowing about the Father” and “knowing the Father”? Jesus always sought to do the will of his Father in heaven, so how does the life of Christ show you how to be a good son to God the Father? What are some attributes of God the Father, and how can you model your own fatherhood on these attributes of the first person of the Holy Trinity?
