Did you know....

As a Knights of Columbus world organization we set new all-time records for charitable donations and volunteer service hours in 2011. Supreme Knight, Carl A. Anderson, released the results of our order's Annual Survey of Fraternal Activities at the recent supreme convention.

The results of the survey indicated that total charitable contributions reached more than 158 million – exceeding the previous year's total by approximately 3.4 million. Our volunteer service hours to charitable causes also grew to more than 70 million hours. It's notable to understand that not every council sends in their report indicating that these numbers are conservative.

One of the Supreme programs that our council has supported for the last two years and intends to support this year as well, is the Global Wheelchair Mission.

The Knights of Columbus and the Global Wheelchair Mission have teamed up to help bring wheelchairs to those who lack freedom of mobility. The Global Wheelchair Mission purchases wheelchairs in bulk and delivers them by sea containers around the world. They are distributed with the help of numerous non-governmental organizations, Rotary, Lions and Kiwanis Clubs, and now the Knights of Columbus.

In 2003, the Knights of Columbus began participating in the Global Wheelchair Mission and sponsored 2,000 wheelchairs to be distributed in Afghanistan. Since then, Knights in the U.S. and Canada have sponsored the distribution of more than 20,000 wheelchairs in Argentina, Colombia, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Guatemala, Jordan, Mexico, Morocco, Oman, Panama, the Philippines, Poland, the United States and Viet Nam.

For every donation of \$150 received by the Global Wheelchair Mission, it can deliver a brand new wheelchair which would cost over \$500 in a medical supply store. They are shipped by 100 to 280 wheelchair containers directly from the factory to the destination countries at no cost to the recipients.

This year will be the third wheelchair our council will donate to a person of need. Three doesn't sound like much - not until it is combined with all the other Knights of Columbus councils' donations and then we begin to recognize the charitable power of the world's largest Catholic men's fraternal organization!

So as Paul Harvey used to say - "So now you know, the rest of the story!"
