Grand Knight's Letter

My Brother Knights,

This is an appointed position responsible for the content of the "Good of the Order" part of our regular Council meetings. This generally includes some educational and/or entertaining material. In our Council, the Lecturer is also responsible for post meeting light refreshments.

The Annual State Organization Meeting and installation of State Officers took place on the weekend of 10 July. Our new State Deputy, Bill McCarthy outlined a challenging program for the new Columbian Year. The focus for the new year is restoration and preservation of the key values of Life, Marriage, and the Family. An essential element in meeting that challenge is prayer, specifically the Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The State Council will be soliciting pledges from all Knights for commitment to daily recitation of the Rosary by at least 12% of the membership, with the objective of one million rosaries offered up for this intention. Coming up in August is our Officer Installation on 21 August. This will take place after the 5:30 p.m. Mass in the Sanctuary followed by refreshments in Monsignor Hannan Hall. All Brother Knights are welcome to attend.

On Friday, 17 September we'll be having our Past Grand Knight Dinner at the International Country Club on Lee Jackson Hwy. It's a great venue and it promises to be a memorable evening. We'll be communicating the details to you all by email. Enjoy the summer!




