## Grand Knight's Letter

### My Brother Knights,

August promises to be a scorcher, many of you are away from home for all or part of the summer, and the pace of council activity is relatively slow. That's not necessarily a bad thing as we transition to a new leadership team, but we do need to look ahead and get our plans in place for the coming year. In particular we need to get our fund raising underway.

Our first officer meeting gave us an opportunity to review the council organization, and formalized some changes among the Service Program Directors. Kevin Craddock has accepted the Faithful Navigator position in the Acts of the Apostles Assembly, and will not be able to continue as our Council Director. He will continue to be active in the Council Service Program, particularly the annual food drive. We will need to fill that position as soon as possible. If you think you might be interested, please let me know. Dave Skouby has generously volunteered to take on the Youth Director role, in addition to his responsibility as Council Recorder. This position has been vacant for some time and we're looking forward to renewed interest in Youth program activities under Dave's direction. Our officer slate includes a strong slate of experienced Knights. However, we are short a Lecturer. This is an appointed position responsible for the content of the "Good of the Order" part of our regular Council meetings. This generally includes some educational and/or entertaining material. In our Council, the Lecturer is also responsible for post meeting light refreshments.

The Annual State Organization Meeting and installation of State Officers took place on the weekend of 10 July. Our new State Deputy, Bill McCarthy outlined a challenging program for the new Columbian Year. The focus for the new year is restoration and preservation of the key values of Life, Marriage, and the Family. An essential element in meeting that challenge is prayer, specifically the Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The State Council will be soliciting pledges from all Knights for commitment to daily recitation of the Rosary by at

least 12% of the membership, with the objective of one million rosaries offered up for this intention. We'll provide more detail on that program as it becomes available. There were several very good presentations by State Council officers committed to providing services to the Councils. The State Membership Director, Steve Raschke has offered the services of several staff members to support Council Membership activities. I expect we'll be taking him up on his offer.

Coming up in August is our Officer Installation on 21 August. This will take place after the 5:30 p.m. Mass in the Sanctuary followed by refreshments in Monsignor Hannan Hall. All Brother Knights are welcome to attend.

On Friday, 17 September we'll be having our Past Grand Knight Dinner at the International Country Club on Lee Jackson Hwy. It's a great venue and it promises to be a memorable evening. We'll be communicating the details to you all by email. Enjoy the summer!

hear and answer me. **Amen.**

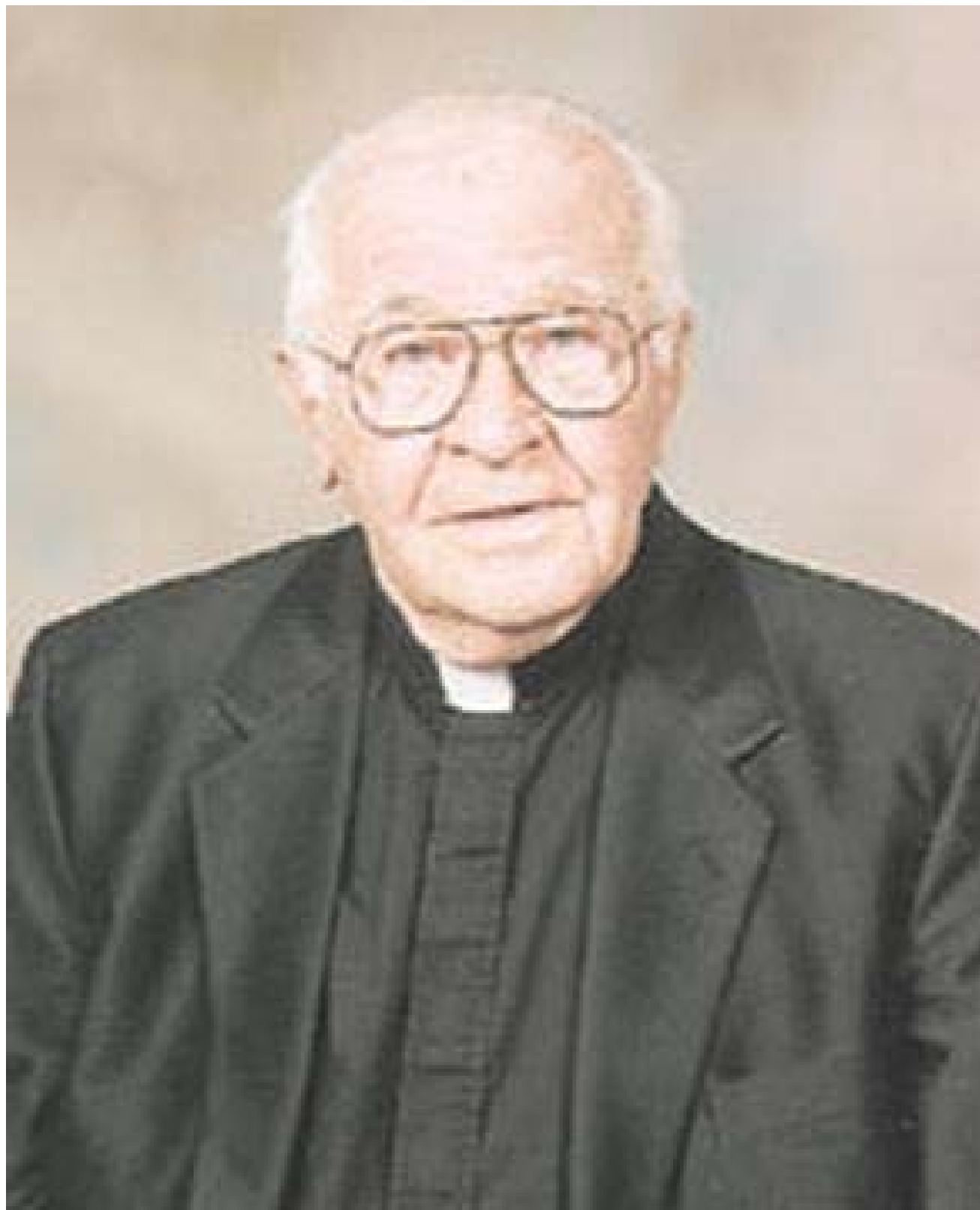
