Grand Knight's Letter

Brothers,

Big things have happened at our first two meetings of this year. We have approved the new form of our bylaws to conform with Supreme's preferred form, as well as the standing resolutions which keep our council-specific rules from the previous bylaws. In addition, we have approved the budget for the coming year. We have many events planned, and we will need all the help that we can get to make these events a success.

The next challenge is determining when all of those events will be held. As you can see from what we currently have on the calendar, we do not yet have much firmed up past the officer installation in August. I know that quite a few people are still on vacation during July and August, but expect to see e-mails coming out with information on September service events and planning beginning for our larger fundraisers, such as Casino Night and the golf tournament.

One new event for this year is a men's retreat. Brother Charlie McCormick has a nearby parcel of land that is well-suited for such events, and has planned other retreats in the past. Anyone interested in helping out, please contact me after a meeting or by e-mail to let me know.

Last year, as the deputy grand knight, I had inquired to see who was interested in picking up a council shirt or council jacket. I'm afraid I didn't follow the chain through to the suppliers here in northern Virginia. While I still have any e-mails that were sent to me last year, I prefer to start over in case anyone's decision has changed since I last asked. As a reminder, only those brothers who have achieved the Third Degree are eligible to purchase council jackets.

That brings me to my final topic – the completion of degrees. All members have gone through the First Degree, but some have remained there, or have achieved the Second Degree but not made it to the Third. Each degree has its own ceremony, and each ceremony has

different lessons to teach about the cardinal virtues of the Knights of Columbus. I urge all of you who are not yet members of the Third Degree to speak with me or the Worthy Chancellor about scheduling your next degree. Being able to purchase a council jacket is a minor benefit, but far more important to the health of the Council is that only knights who have obtained the Third Degree are eligible to become officers. Even as this year starts, we have to look down the road to the next year, and the next, and the next. I believe that this council will continue to do its good works for years to come, but it is up to all of us to make that a reality.

If you haven't thought about it, please consider joining one of our donut teams. Each team is responsible for a single Sunday's sale of donuts every two months or so. It's a good chance for the Knights to make ourselves known, as well as giving the parish a chance to meet up with one another outside of Mass.

Finally, I am selling Virginia Knights of Columbus College Football Frenzy Sweepstakes tickets. They are \$10.00 each and half of the proceeds to go our council. Please contact me if you are interested in purchasing one (or more), or would like to sell them after masses on Sunday, especially when we have our coffee and donuts events. I have to turn in the sweepstakes stubs, collected money, and any unsold tickets (hopefully there won't be any) by September 11, 2011. The sweepstakes starts on October 8, 2011 and continues for 8 weeks, ending on November 26, 2011. Prizes are awarded weekly to the ticket holders with the 4 teams that score the most or the least number of points. These 4-team totals are called the "Highest 4-Team Totals" and the "Lowest 4-Team Totals."
