The program has continued since then as a project in several jurisdictions. Each year, a Silver Rose "honoring of Our Lady of Guadalupe and reaffirming our commitment to the sanctity of human life", is carried by Knights from Canada, through the United States, and into Mexico to arrive at the Basilica in Monterrey, Mexico on December 12, Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. This year, three Silver Roses are traveling from Canada to Mexico.

A Silver Rose ceremony was held on June 20, 2015 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church. As your Grand Knight I had the opportunity to participate in this beautiful ceremony with other councils in the district.
