Build a Domestic Church








Growing Our Council

Guest Speaker - Julia Hess "The SPRED JOURNEY"



Working as a SPRED Community Religious Worker for over 35 years, Julia shares the Good News in the life of a parish SPRED program.

"We are ready to look at the present and contemplate strategies to attend to both the current and future needs of our SPRED friends. Friends who have reached a point of transition were also identified triggering a discussion. Who goes on the waiting list? ... the Friend who is no longer comfortable in an age group? or the Friend who has not yet been in the program? How does the syllabus honor the chronological age of the Friend? Can a child with a disability sense the need to move on? What are some of the signs of disconnection? When is it necessary for a group to change from one age group to another? And ... what does the change entail regarding environment; choice of activities and change of the mindset of the catechists ... to be able to recognize that the person is no longer a child, but instead an adult with adult needs. How does changing an age group affect other parishes and SPRED communities. Whew! Many thoughts and concerns ... definitely just scratched the surface ... Your thoughts are appreciated."
