Eagles-Cowboys tickets raffle

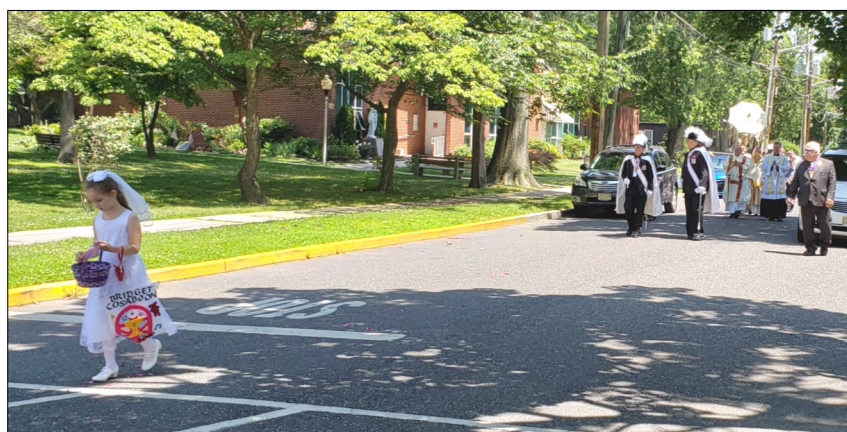

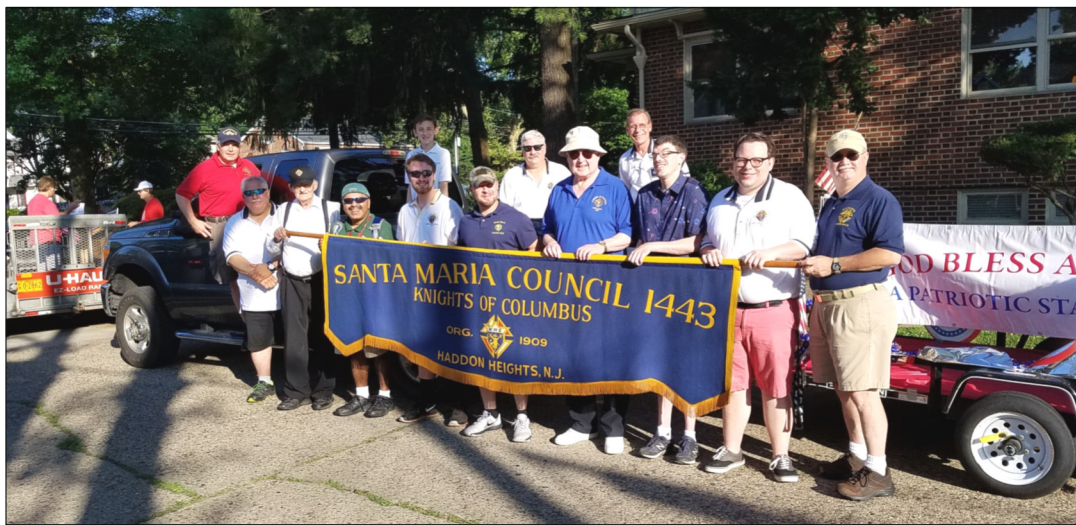
