
Advancement to 2nd Formation Degree

Venerable Father McGivney



Parish Priest

Did you know in 1879 Father McGivney was stationed at St. Mary's Church in New Haven, CT? St. Mary's was built in the 1870's and accumulated over \$200,000 in debt. Father Patrick Murphy was the Pastor and became sickly leaving the newly ordained priest of 6 months Father Michael McGivney to run the parish. When Father Murphy died, Father McGivney ran the parish for over a month before a new Pastor was appointed. He could not be the permanent pastor as he was only a priest for one year. He immediately was tasked with building attendance and paying down the debt.

Father McGivney came up with a great idea on how to raise money and pay down the debt. It was a "coffee festival". A combination of coffee with desserts and a bit of entertainment. It was supposed to run only one night, but due to the overwhelming attendance, it stayed open a week. It netted quite a nice sum which helped pay down the debt on the church property.
