Santa Maria Council mourns Michael J. Weiglein, PGK, FDD

In the past six months, Santa Maria Council #1443 has lost several active members, including Rich Lipko, Walt Heim and Paul Campana, Jr. The sad news continued on July 7th with the passing at age 77 of Mike Weiglein, pictured here with Chancellor Anthony Albanese, his son-in-law, and PGK Jerry Burke. Mike contributed greatly to the success of the Council.



He was a past Grand Knight and Former District Deputy, and was a 4th Degree member in the Bishop Eustace General Assembly where he had served as Color Corps Commander. With his wife, Ellen, the Weigleins ran Council's Sisters Night and made it a treat for nuns all over South Jersey. They established the SSG Joseph M. Weiglein Memorial Foundation in 2007 after SSG Weiglein, their son, was killed in while serving in Iraq. An annual fall event has funded one of the most generous scholarships awarded at Audubon High School. Mike tirelessly gave to the Church and the community. He served as a head usher, maintenance person and even a CCD teacher at St. Vincent Pallotti Church. He also co-chaired the Audubon Citizens Celebration Committee for over 25 years. Mike Weiglein was the model of a "Catholic gentleman." He is missed.

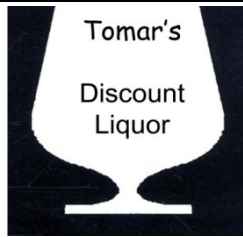
