# A Lady Knight's Thoughts

As we begin to close out summer, we find the feast days of many great saints to whom we can look for inspiration. August 1st is the feast of St. Alphonsus de Liguori who was a great preacher of the Gospel to the poor in the mid 1700's. August 4th is the feast of St. John Vianney, a French priest in the early 1800's. He is the patron of priests and confessors. The feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord is celebrated on August 6th. Jesus appeared in all His Glory to Saints Peter, James and John on Mount Thabor. August 14th is the feast of Saint Maximilian Kolbe, a Polish Franciscan friar who, in 1941, volunteered to die in the place of a fellow prisoner at Auschwitz, the German death camp during WWII. On August 15th we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary who was taken into Heaven, body and soul. Saint Pius X became Pope in 1903 and we celebrate his feast day on August 21st. The following day, August 22nd, we celebrate the queenship of Mary. Our Blessed Mother was crowned queen of heaven and earth! St. Monica's feast day is August 27th. A mother in the mid 300's, Monica spent years praying for the conversion of her son, Augustine, whose feast is August 28th. Monica is the patron saint of mothers, among many other causes. Augustine, her converted wayward son, is named as one of the many doctors of our Catholic Church. We round out August with the Martyrdom of St. John the Baptist on the 29th.
