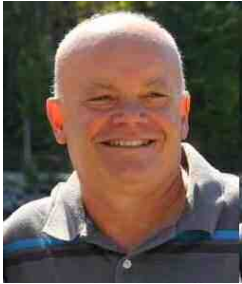

## ENGAGING IN SERVICE

This is the second of several monthly articles that outlines what our duty as Knights of Columbus truly is. Going to meetings is just not enough to fulfil our obligations and the principles of the order. Our work as Knights is focussed around six main service categories of Church, Community, Council, Culture of Life, Family and Youth. The K of C “Service Program” is organized around these topics. In this article we’ll focus on the “Church,” and ways that we, as Knights, can dedicate our time and effort in supporting this category.

**Church:** As Catholics, we are called to take an active part in building a strong parish, Church and community. The Church is searching for ways to expand its reach. As Knights we need to practice our faith and be a constant and worthy example of an ideal Catholic for our family, community and brother Knights.

An excellent way to bring this about is through the Parish Round Table program. Get involved. Be a spokesperson between your parish and your council. Offer the services of your council to your parish by making them known to everyone.

Another way is to be “Professors of the Catholic faith.” By being a good Catholic model with your non-Catholic family, friends and associates, you may arouse interest in our faith. Invite them to tour a church in your area. Ask your pastor to lead a tour and explain points of interest such as the baptismal font, the tabernacle, Stations of the Cross, the sacristy, a display of the vestments and sacred vessels. Ask them to join you in attending a Mass or social event. Lend them a video or a book on Catholicism.

Another way we as Knights can support the “Church” is by recognizing people receiving their First Communion, council and parish families baptizing children, and individuals receiving confirmation, with congratulations cards, certificates or special appreciation gifts.

These are just a few ways in which we can support the church and increase our visibility in the church community. There are several more ways which will be discussed in next month’s newsletter.

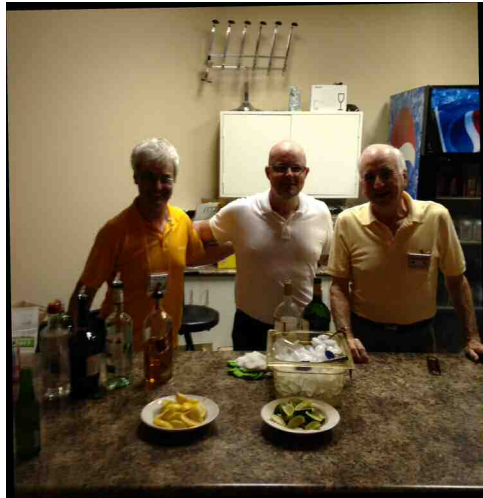
