#### **Ron Blanchard**



## Reader's **Review** by Dave Conca



Called to Love

Over the centuries, there has been plenty of discussion concerning the dichotomy of the body and the soul and how human sexual urges can undermine spirituality. Pope John Paul II very well may have been the first to look at the traditional mind set on this subject when he wrote Man and Woman, He Created Them: A Theology of the Body, a series of lectures that evolved into encyclicals, letters, and published exhortations. Through a series of talks that are known as the theology of the body, he explained the divine meaning of human sexuality and why the body provides answers to questions about our lives.

Called to Love, Supreme Knight, Carl Anderson, along with Fr. Jose Granados, the assistant professor of patrology and systematic theology at the Pontifical John Paul II Institute for Studies on Marriage and Family in Rome, collaborate to discuss the philosophical and religious significance of the theology of the body in a deeply spiritual way. They explain how the body speaks of God, revealing His goodness, and also what it means to be called to a vocation of love.

This books takes John Paul II's heartfelt teachings and gives readers a new understanding of the Christian way of love and how to embrace it fully in their lives.

Called to Love ties in diverse contemplation on this topic, such as, Dante's Inferno to Pope Benedict XVI's interpretation of the human body and how we should fully use this gift, in unity with the soul, to love and serve God.

This book is thoughtful and accessible: a fine choice for Catholic couples.
