- 1. Fill out the Catholic Citizenship Essay Entry Form
 - a. Check the appropriate grade block
 - b. Leave council number blank
 - c. Fill in name, date of birth, address, phone number and email address
 - d. Sign the entry form
- 2. Parent/Guardian Section
 - a. Leave council number blank
 - b. Have parent/guardian sign and date the form
- 3. For an example of a completed form, please see the Sample Catholic Citizenship Entry Form
- 4. Write your essay
 - a. Theme is "Describe everyday obstacles that you may have experienced or witnessed others experiencing while living a life of authentic faith. Explain how you have overcome these obstacles and how, by doing so, it has helped your faith to continue to grow."
 - Must be typed. DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THE ACTUAL ESSAY. Your name should
 ONLY appear on the entry form
 - c. Must be typed and 500 750 words in length
 - d. Attach your essay to your Catholic Citizenship Entry Form
- 5. Submission Instructions
