The National Catholic Bioethics Center (NCBC) has selected Dallas for their 2011 Bishop's workshop to be held February 13-17, 2011. The workshop will be held at the Omni Mandalay Hotel at Las Colinas located at 221 E Las Colinas Blvd, Irving, Texas. The Bishops will start arriving for the NEA Conference which begins on February 10th. The meetings will involve a number of Bishops from the United States, Mexico, Central America, South America and the Caribbean.

We are asking each Grand Knight and Faithful Navigator to coordinate this effort to solicit drivers and airport greeters, and distribute the enclosed Volunteer Form. We need the Volunteer Form to be completed and returned to the address shown on the form, no later than January 10, 2011. You are welcome to make additional copies as needed. Driver/greeter assignments will be mailed no later than <u>January 25, 2011</u>. Also enclosed is a suggested article to include in your council/assembly newsletter to solicit drivers.

The majority of drivers and airport greeters are needed on Monday, February 13, 2011; however several drivers will also be needed from Thursday, February 10 thru Thursday, February 17, 2011 for pick up and/or returns. We are estimating about 20 for the NEA meeting and 200 for the NCBC workshop. Drivers are also encouraged to assist in return transportation, particularly on Wednesday, February 16th and Thursday, February 17th. 
