## "Sacramental Gifts" Initiative of the K of C "Faith in Action" Program

Approx. 30 parishioners receiving the Sacrament of Baptism on Holy Saturday and 70 parish children who received their First Communion last weekend were each given rosary beads by our Council as "Sacramental Gifts" to commemorate their reception of theses Sacraments.



This new "Sacramental Gift" initiative of the Knights of Columbus "Faith in Action" Program signifies a new emphasis by the Knights on the spiritual dimension of our parish and community involvement.

Lanny Breczinski made an apt analogy at a recent Council meeting to describe the change from "Surge in Service" to "Faith in Action" when he likened it to the attitudes of Martha and Mary during a visit of Jesus to their home. Martha focused on service (the meal preparation, setting the table, etc.), while Mary sat at the feet of Jesus and hung on his every word. Jesus pointed out to Martha that Mary taken the better path.


#### Rest in Peace, Brother Joe Miller
