Invitation to Join St. Joseph County Formation Degree Team

Brother Knights,

The Mid-Year District Deputies' meeting in December 2016 brought forth the announcement that there would be a change in degree team responsibilities. Beginning January 2018, the District Deputies would be responsible for organizing the Formation Degree (formerly known as 2nd Degree). Former District Deputies Rick Alexander (District 10) and Brad Soule (District 11) agreed to form one degree team for all of St. Joseph County. We see this as a means to benefit our Admission (1st) Degree Knights on their journey into Knighthood.

We began putting out the word at Council meetings, looking for brother Knights who would be interested in serving on the Degree Team. We held an interest meeting this past spring and began gathering the Team. Our current District Deputies Rick Burmeister (District 10) and Gil Martin (District 11) have appointed Rick Alexander as the Degree Team Captain. We began in earnest in August to parcel out speaking parts and work out details. Recently, we were surprised to find out that many of our brother Knights were not aware that a Formation Degree Team was being formed here in St. Joseph County. We are now reaching out through our Council newsletters to ask our Brother Knights to join us. We would like to have more Brothers involved to help accommodate situations where one or more team members are not available on a given date.

We were certified in November and will hold our first official degree in mid-December. What are the requirements to be on the team? We will be wearing yellow and white sashes instead of robes.

After our first few degrees, we anticipate holding degrees at least once a quarter, all at councils or parishes in St. Joseph County.


