## WHEELCHAIR MISSION

In communication with Sisters Michele O'Brien and Michele Reinarz of the Christus Santa Rosa Children's Hospital, SK PGK Jon Klauenberg found out that the hospital was in the need of 25 wheelchairs of various sizes. Based on this need, 26 wheelchairs were delivered to the hospital on Monday, November 16.

## **CHURCH NEW VIDEO SYSTEM**

In addition to the wheelchair support in November, several Knights assisted in establishing a video system for the church. An anonymous donor purchased the cameras and computer. Brother SK Gary Richmond was asked to help with devising a list of network needs to link the cameras and the computer and the sound board. 1000ft of Cat 6 internet cables was laid into the church in the ceiling and crawl spaces to make this happen. Brother Knights SK Sal Scalia, SK Gerald Gaenslen, John Goetz, SK Gary Adams, and SK Leo Forget assisted with this installation and made this a reality. Soon to be connected will be the camera in the day chapel and possibly one in the Adoration chapel.

### **CHICKEN BBQ**

As included in the November Newsletter, our Knights performed a very high performing work on October 3 and 4 (Saturday and Sunday) in producing a large number of barbequed chickens in order to obtain funds for college tuitions. This event was quite a success in that it acquired \$3,000.
