### Thanksgiving Food Drive

The Father Julius J. Cilinski Council (#10947) conducted its annual Father Charles A. Ryan Memorial Thanksgiving Food Drive for less fortunate families living in the Fairfax County area on Saturday, November 17th and Sunday, November 18th. With the help of 27 Brother Knights, their families and friends, and the generosity of our fellow parishioners we collected 243 boxed meals, 183 turkeys, and many miscellaneous food items. Of these amounts, the St Clare Council (12963) contributed 39 boxed meals, 29 turkeys, and 7 boxes of miscellaneous items. Here's a breakdown of what was delivered the St. Andrew the Apostle Parish and local food pantries:

St Andrews the Apostle Parish:

25 boxed meals, 20 turkeys, a \$25 Giant gift card, 12

boxes of miscellaneous, 16 bags of canned goods, 6 cases of corn, and 2 cases of green beans.

### WFCM Food Pantry:

130 boxed meals, 100 turkeys, 2 cases of corn, 3 cases of green bens, 4 boxes of fruit, and a box of miscellaneous items. The coordinator at WFCM was about brought to tears with our donations. To say that they were thankful would be an understatement.

#### SERVE:

88 boxed meals and 63 turkeys.

Total weight of boxed meals: 20 lbs/box X 243 = 4860 lb Total weight of turkeys: 15 lbs x 183 = 2745 lb Total weight of Miscellaneous cans/food items = 300 lb Total weight of food donated and delivered = 7905 lb

The Supreme Master announced that the Supreme Board of Directors has approved the elimination of the six month requirement as a member of the Knights of Columbus to become a member of the Fourth Degree, if the candidate is a third degree member in good standing. Basically, this means that a waiver of the sixmonth requirement is no longer needed to take the Fourth Degree.

The next Fourth Degree Exemplification will be May 18, 2013 at St. Leo's in Fairfax. It should be a one-day event.
