Grand Knights Letter

Brothers,

November gave us many things to be thankful for - friends, family, church and our Knights of Columbus Order. I am truly thankful for another very successful annual Father Ryan Memorial Thanksgiving Day Food Drive. Through $_{
m the}$ generosity of parishioners and the hard work of our Knights and family members, we collected a total of 246 boxed meals and 209 turkeys. Of this amount, St. Clare's collected 43 boxed meals and 52 turkeys. Here's a breakdown of the food donations that we made:

- 18 boxed meals and 18 turkeys to St. Andrew the Apostle Catholic Church
- 135 boxed meals and 135 turkeys to Western Fairfax Christian Ministries
- 79 boxed meals and 42 turkeys to SERVE
- 14 boxed meals and 14 turkeys to K Neal Idealease

A huge thank you to our Food Drive Chairman, Mark Mulholland for the outstanding planning, coordination and execution to this year's Thanksgiving Day Food Drive. Well Done Mark!
