# **Immaculate Conception**

The month of December is dedicated to the Immaculate Conception, which is celebrated on December 8. The first 24 days of December fall during the liturgical season known as Advent and are represented by the liturgical color purple. The remaining days of December mark the beginning of the Christmas season.

Immaculate Conception, according to the teaching of the Catholic Church, was the conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary in her mother's womb free from original sin. The Catholic Church teaches Mary was conceived by normal biological means, but her soul was acted upon (kept "immaculate") at the time of her conception. The doctrine was not dogmatically defined until 1854, by Pope Pius IX in his papal bull Ineffabilis Deus.

The Catholic Church celebrates the Feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8; in many Catholic countries, it is a holy day of obligation or patronal feast, and in some a national public holiday.

During this month of December, Christmas falls on December 25, which is an annual commemoration of the birth of Jesus Christ. "Christmas" is a compound word originating in the term "Christ's Mass". Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus to the Virgin Mary as a fulfillment of the Old Testament's Messianic prophecy. As we celebrate Immaculate Conception and Christmas this month, let's prayer to Our Blessed Mother Mary for giving us her Son and savior Jesus Christ to be among us and bring his peace on earth and families.

O God, who by the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, did prepare a worthy dwelling place for Your Son, we beseech You that, as by the foreseen death of this, Your Son, You did preserve her from all stain, so too you would permit us, purified through her intercession, to come unto You. Through the same Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, world without end. Amen.


# From the Deputy Grand Knight

It did not matter to me if the child was a boy or a girl; my only prayer was that each child be healthy Today, Mike and Erin are grown, educated, employed, and out of the house. For too many families in Virginia, their children were born with an intellectual disability. These families face challenges Kathy and I never had to consider as we raised our children. Most significant is the challenge of providing life-long adult supervision to a child who may not be able to drive, work to support themselves, balance a checkbook, or arrange for their own healthcare.

As Catholic men and women who support our Church's pro-life stance, we have an opportunity to assist these families in many ways. One of them is by contributing to KOVAR. KOVAR is our Knights of Columbus charity which provides grants and interest-free mortgages to not-for-profit organizations which work to improve the quality of life of Virginians with intellectual disabilities.
