Many of the program's trainees do not have a valid driver's license, hence the need for a volunteer to drive the van to accompany a trainee in delivering and setting up catering orders. Volunteers are asked to sign up for a weekly shift. Qualifications Include: a valid driver's license, be age 21 or over, pass a driving record background check, a driving test, and the ability to do moderate lifting (15 to 25 pounds) and bending.
