#### Knights Donate Outdoor Stations of the Cross to Holy Spirit Parish



One of the first actions taken by Brother Knight, Father Mike Werkhoven upon his appointment as Pastor at Holy Spirit four years ago, was to install outdoor Stations of the Cross. Some may not know that these stations feature original art produced by Father Mike.

During Stations this past Good Friday, some Knights observed that the years have not been kind to many of the stations which have seriously deteriorated due to weathering. The Holy Spirit

Knights set out immediately to research appropriate replacements that would both honor Father Mike's wishes and represent the sanctity of the Stations of the Cross.

Stations produced by Wayside Shrines, Bloomfield, Indiana, were identified and suggested to Father Mike who wholeheartedly approved them. The Stations of the Cross are designed to be richly traditional and consist of exterior grade, weather-resistant porcelain/ceramic. The religious artwork image for each station is recreated from original Italian antique paintings and contained within a rustic Gothic style carved housing made of western red cedar.

The Holy Spirit Knights are proud to donate these wonderful stations to the parish in honor of the legacy created by Brother Knight, Father Mike.
